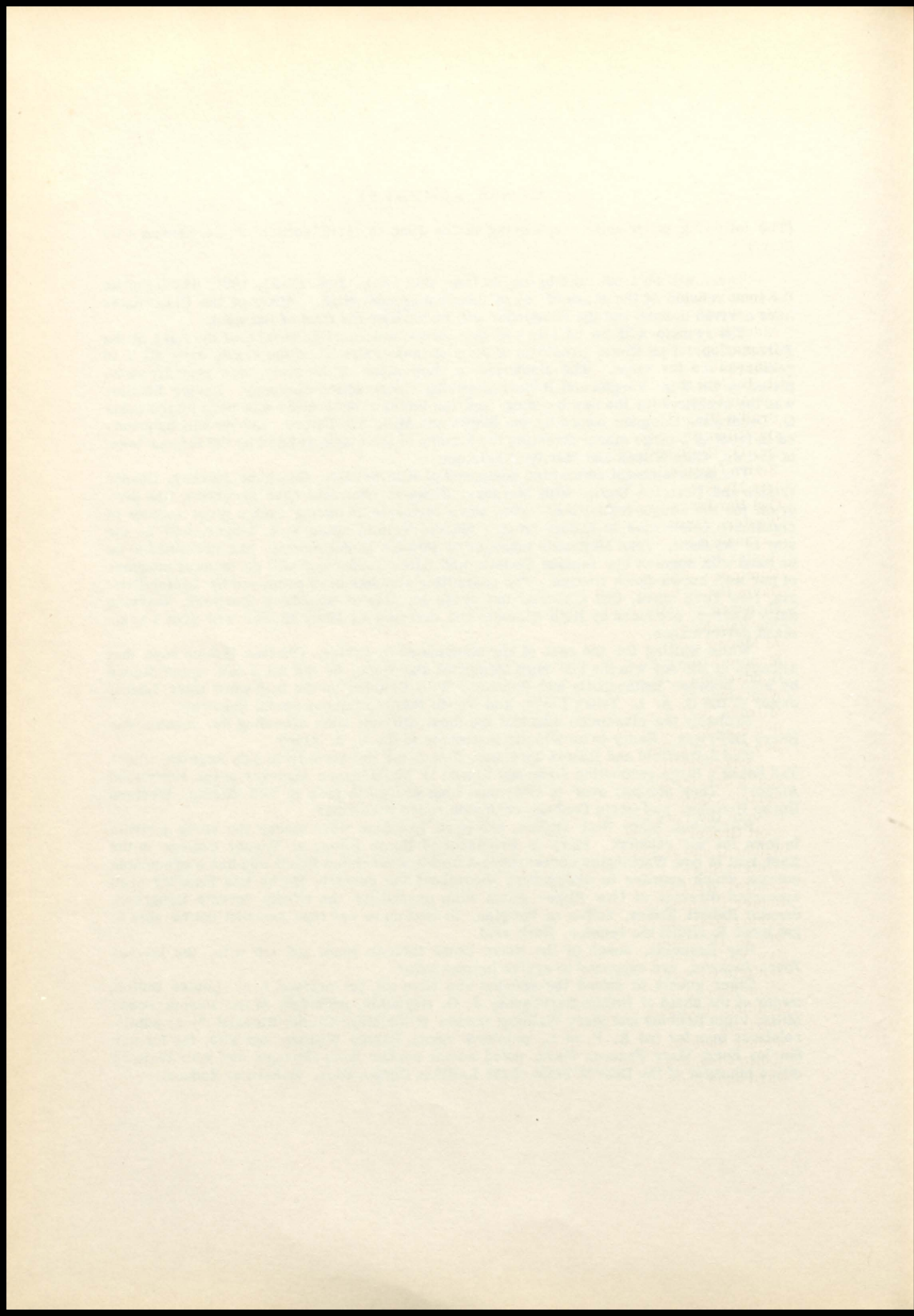
Probably the classmate who had the most difficult time attending the reunion was Henry DePriest. Henry is an athletic instructor in the U. S. Army.

Ray Reynolds, coach of the Notre Dame football team and his wife, the former Joyce Jackson, are supposed to arrive in town today.

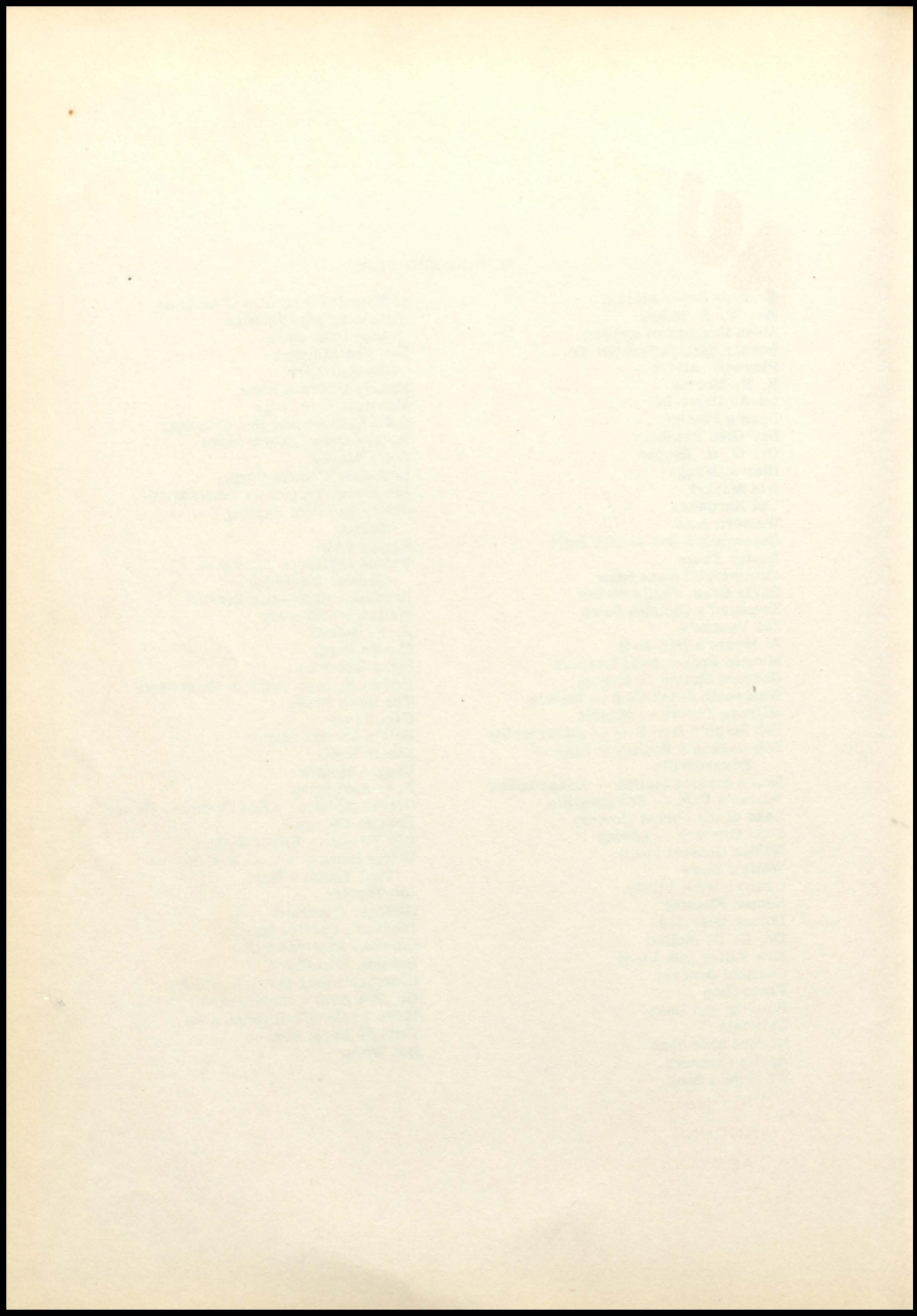

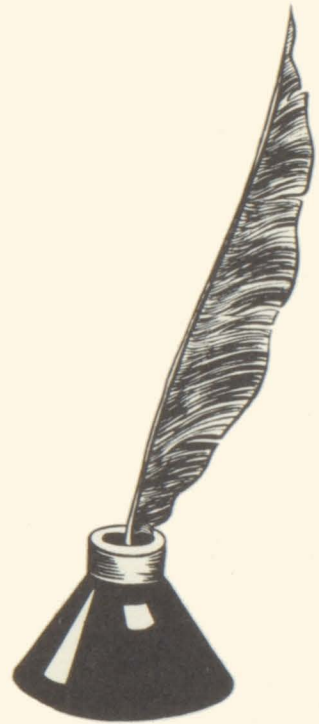
