However, the juniors didn't just work that year. There was a certain group of juniors who painted the town red (red '59's, that is).

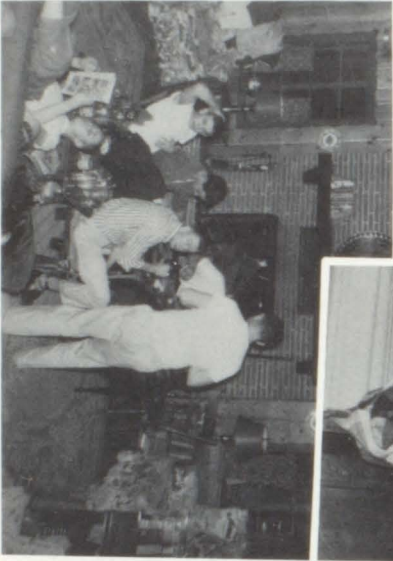
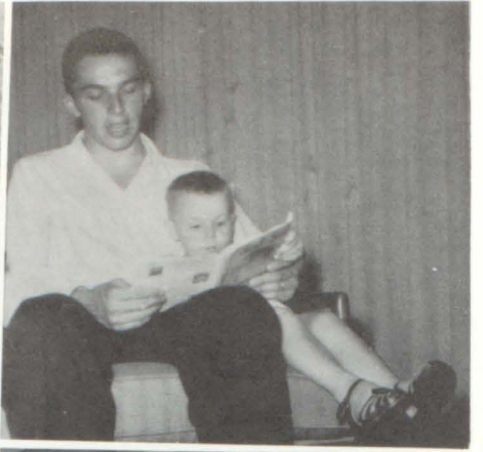

Now we are seniors and are at the peak of activities. Some of the seniors are making plans to take a trip to New Orleans. They will be sponsored by some of the parents.

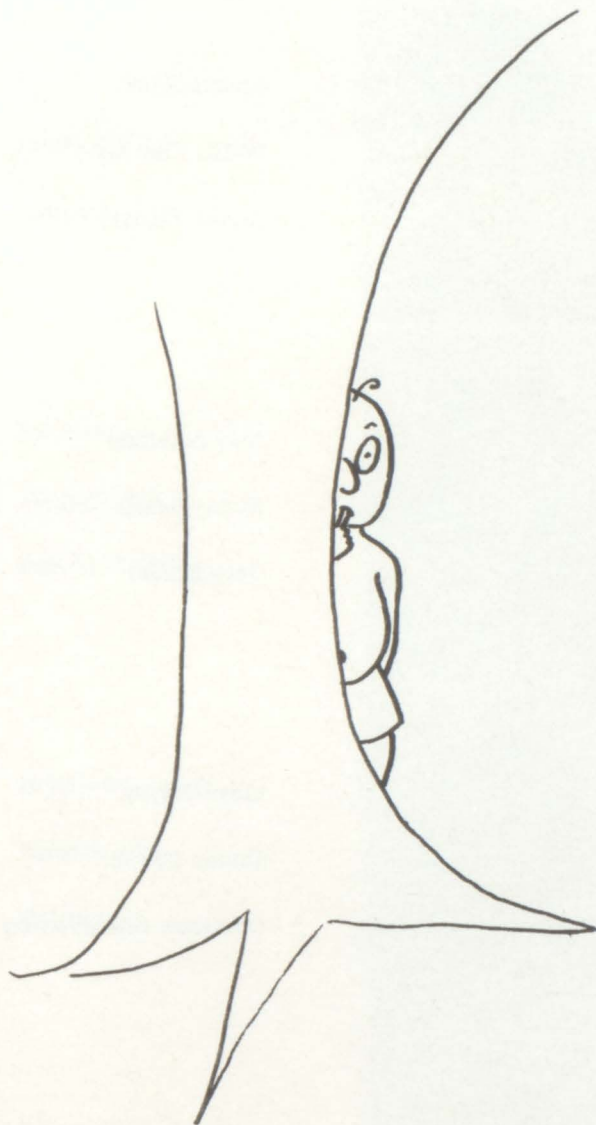
The seniors presented "The Family Nobody Wanted" for our play. We have sold subscriptions to magazines, had a turkey dinner, sold Chieftains, etc.

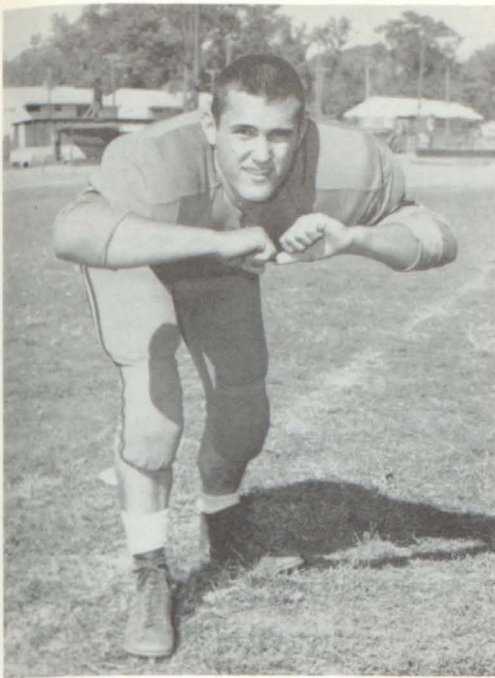
COACHES

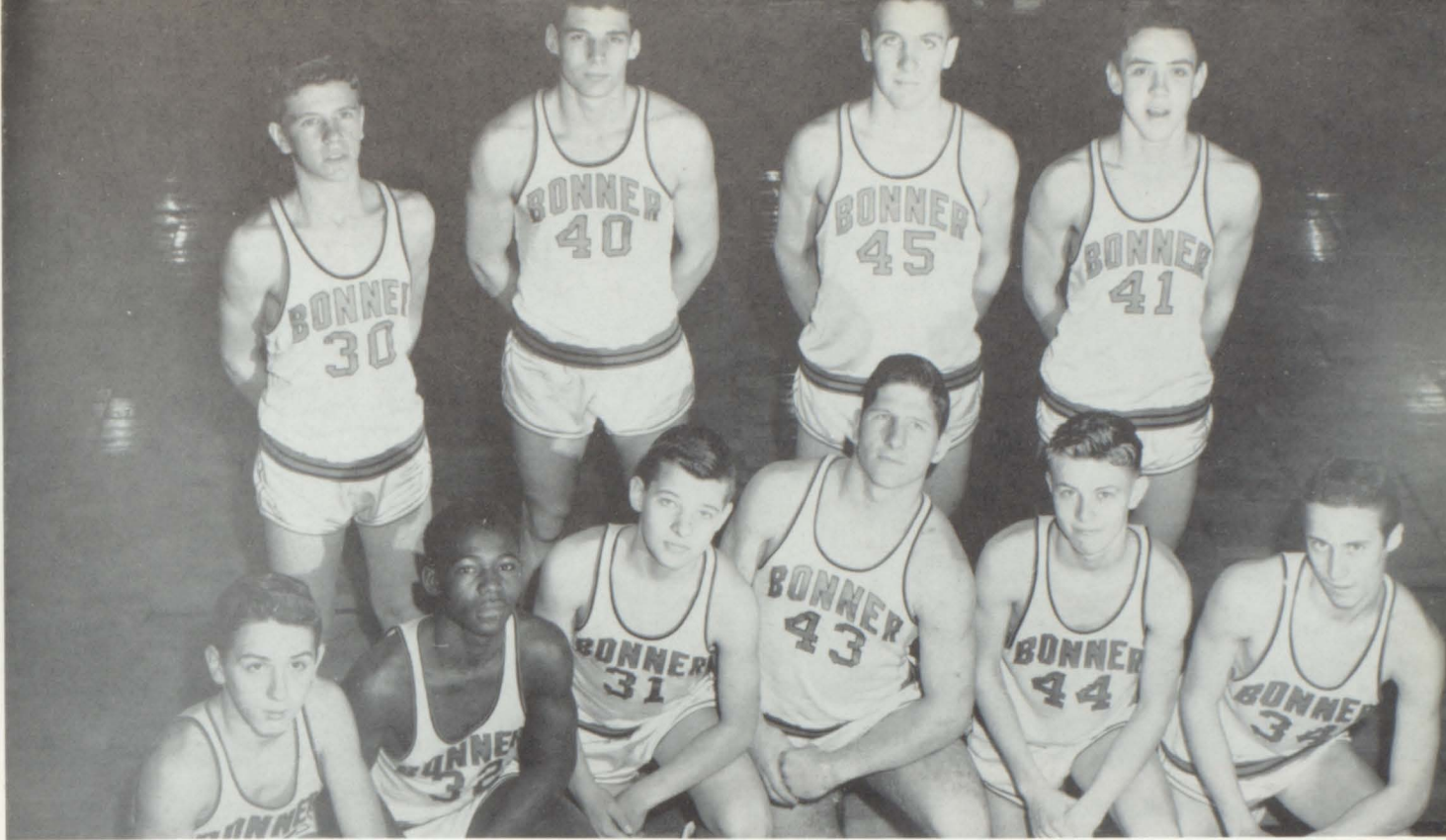
BASKETBALL
